The shawl maker begins with prayers and blessings for the recipient. The prayers/blessings are continued throughout the making of the shawl. When done, a final blessing is offered before the shawl is given to the intended receiver. Some recipients can continue the kindness by making a shawl and passing it onto someone in need. Thus, the blessing continues from person-to-person, with both the giver and receiver feeling the unconditional embrace of a loving, comforting, caring God!
